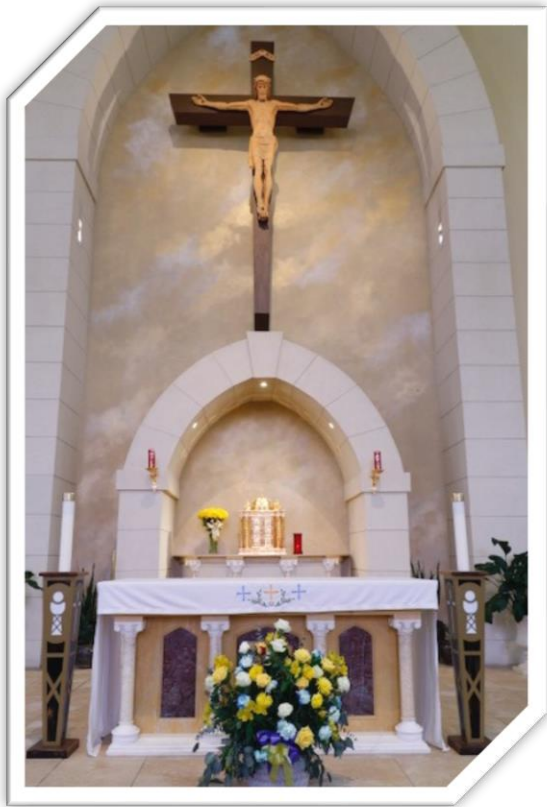

First Sunday of Lent

Your all invited to participate in CRS Rice Bowl during Lent.

CRS Rice Bowl is Catholic Relief Services Lenten faith-in-action program. It offers opportunities for your family to engage daily in the spiritual pillars of Lent: prayers, fasting and almsgiving. And it's an opportunity for us as a parish member to come together as aa community and reflects on what it means to live out our Gospel call to go out and encounter those most in need.

During the next 40 days, we will encounter the stories of people in Iraq, Nicaragua, Burkina Faso and other places around the world where CRS is at work. We'll be invited to eat simple, meatless meals each Friday and through the stories well learn about the principle of Catholic social teaching-and ways we can put them into action during Lent and beyond.

*We will reflect on how an encounter with our neighbors can be transformative. We will see how our prayers, fasting and almsgiving can support **THAT WORLDWIDE WHO** are forced to flee their homes to find safety or better opportunities.*

I'm excited to take journey with our parish and to connect the prayer and reflections of each of our families to our global community of faith. I hope you will take home a CRS Rice bowl, located in the entrance of the church.

As We look ahead to our Lenten journey, may our fasting be a hungry for justice, our alms an offering of peace, and our prayers a reflection of humble and grateful hearts. We ask the Holy Spirit to accompany us as we spend these 40 days reflecting on what it means to be companions on the journey to encounter our global human family. How many this encounter with our neighbors transform our own lives? How many our prayers, fasting and almsgiving support those worldwide who are forced to flee their homes for safety or better opportunities? We ask this through our Lord Jesus Christ, who lives and reigns with the Father and the Holy Spirit, one God forever and ever. Amen

This Sunday we are celebrating the Rite of Sending and call to continuing Conversion at 9:00am mass. The Rite of sending offers the parish community an opportunity to acknowledge the spiritual progress the catechumens and candidates have made, express approval of their election or recognition, and end them forth to our Bishop Tyson with assurance of the parish's care and support.

In sacred Scripture, the Book of Revelation makes reference to a "Book of Life", in which are written the names of those who have chosen to follow the Lord Jesus and be baptized. Those who are already baptized, as Catholics or in other denominations, had our names written in the Book of Life at our Baptism. In this Rite, those preparing for Baptism are invited to come forward and sign a book, which we call the Book of Elect, 'as a sign of their desire to be numbered among the chosen of God. Those who have been baptized already are 'called to continuing conversion'. The Rite step toward their reception of the sacraments during Easter Vigil.



Although those who are receiving only confirmation do not participate in the rite of sending or rite of election, we ask for your prayers for them and their Grandparent(s), as well as all our catechumens and Candidates."
