***We often cite Jesus quote from todays Gospel of Mark' Go into the whole world and proclaim the gospel to every creature." This was not a suggestion from the Lord. It is incredible how this Church has grown from one man/God and a small group into what it is today. That does not, however get us off the hook." As much as we may argue about how to carry out this command from Jesus the fact remain that our very lives need to stand as representation of what it means to be a Christian what it means to Love one another, what it means to live and to work as a disciple of Christ.
